




- 1. God was before all and Jesus was with Him.




God Makes the World Genesis 1



In the beginning God made the heavens and the earth. Grass and trees and flowers began to grow on the earth. *Genesis 1:1-12*







Genesis 1—God Makes the Animals **Animal Mobile**

Supplies


copies of the Animal Mobile (preferably on white card stock) for each child crayons or markers scissors hole punch varying lengths of yarn (5 per student, any color)

Directions


Color the word strip and the three mobile pieces that show animal pictures. On the fourth mobile piece, draw and color your favorite animal. Cut out all of the mobile pieces. Punch five holes in the word strip where the small circles are shown. Punch one hole at the top of each of the mobile pieces. Using varying lengths of yarn, tie each mobile piece to the word strip. Tie the fifth piece of yarn to the top center hole of the word strip and loop it at the top so the mobile can be hung. Use the mobile to tell about what God made on days 5 and 6 of creation.





Construction paper—many colors Yarn White glue Paper punch Branch from a tree (optional) Patterns—bird and wings (page 38)

Directions:


Before class cut out one bird and one pair of wings per child. Punch a hole near the center of the bird and slits where indicated on pattern. Cut yarn into 15" lengths. Give each child a bird, a pair of wings, and one piece of yarn. Show how to insert the wings in the slits in the body of the bird. Assist the children in securing the yarn in the hole in the birds' bodies. Allow the children to "fly" their birds inside, or, if space is limited, take them outside for a walk.


If you wish, bring in a tree branch and set it upright in a coffee can filled with gravel or dirt. After the children "fly" their birds, let them nest their birds in the tree branch for the rest of the classtime.




God made the stars and moon to shine at night. He made the sun to shine in the daytime. *Genesis 1:14-18*




