

Lesson 3 - Temptation and Fall

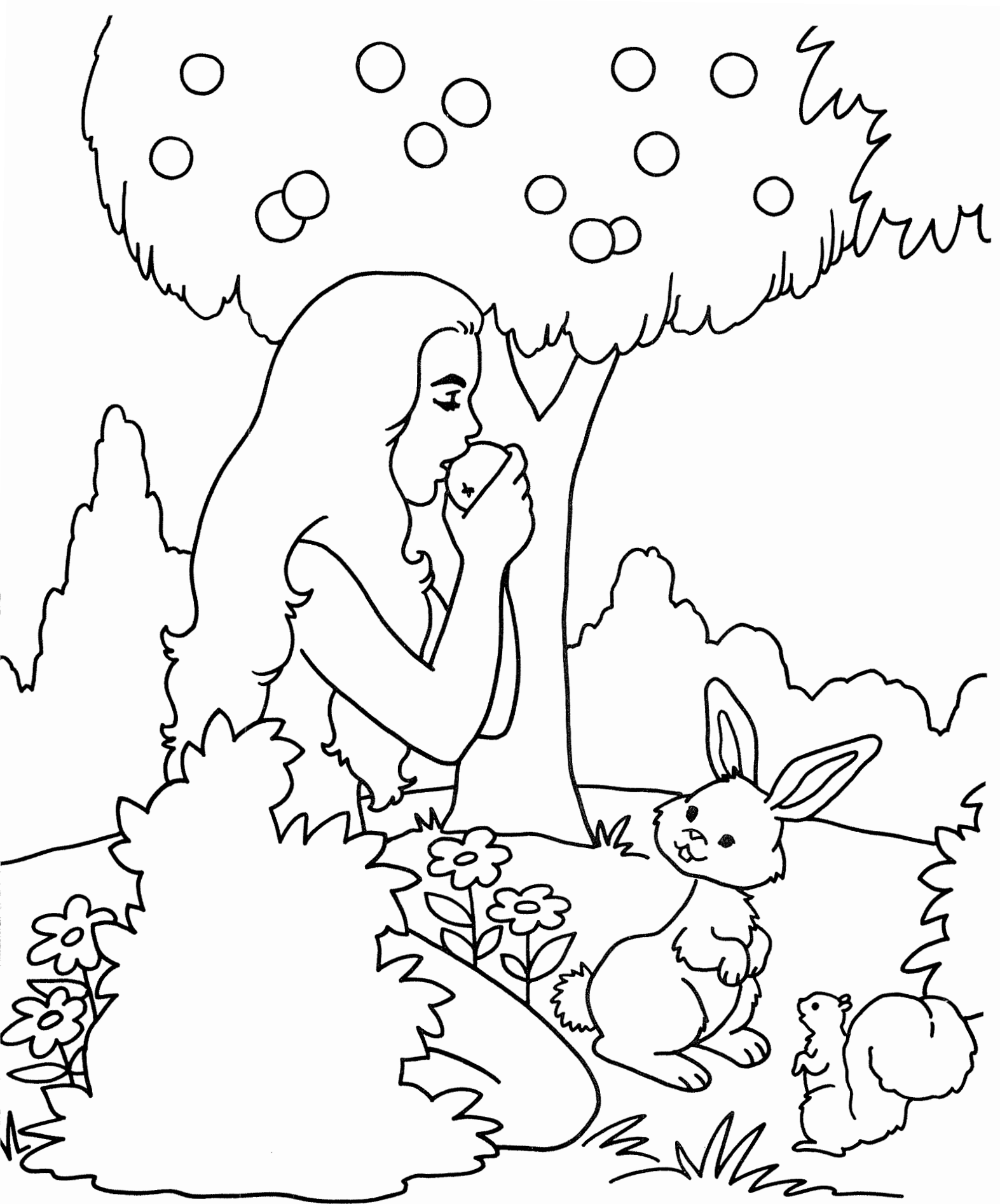
Genesis 3

Key Verse

Genesis 3:8, “And they heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God among the trees of the garden.”

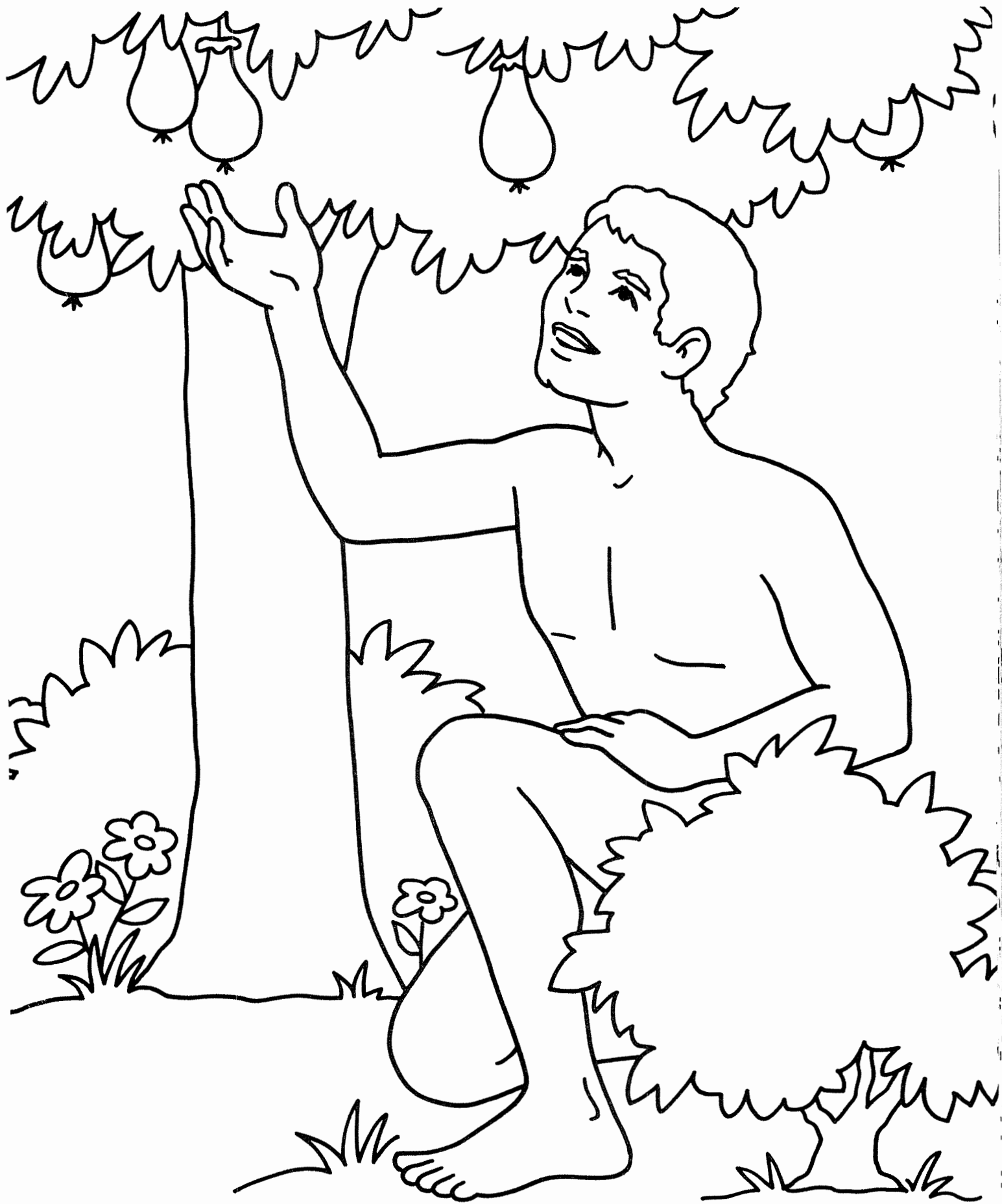
Key Points

1. God gave Adam and Eve only one rule in the garden: not to eat of the tree in the middle of the garden.
2. Satan deceived Eve, and she disobeyed by eating fruit from the tree. She encouraged Adam, and he ate, too. Both having their eyes opened, they knew they had sinned and tried to hide from God.
3. God confronted Adam and Eve about their sin and made clothes for them of animal skins.
4. The serpent, the man, and the woman were to suffer the consequences of God's judgment because of their sin.
5. The Tree of Knowledge changed how man would live and die and led to the need for Jesus as a sacrifice for our sins.



God told Adam and Eve they could eat any fruit in the garden except for one kind. One day, the devil tempted Eve to eat that fruit.

Genesis 2:16, 17; 3:1-6



Adam also ate the fruit. Then Adam and Eve were ashamed, and tried to hide from God. But no one can hide from God.

Genesis 3:6-8



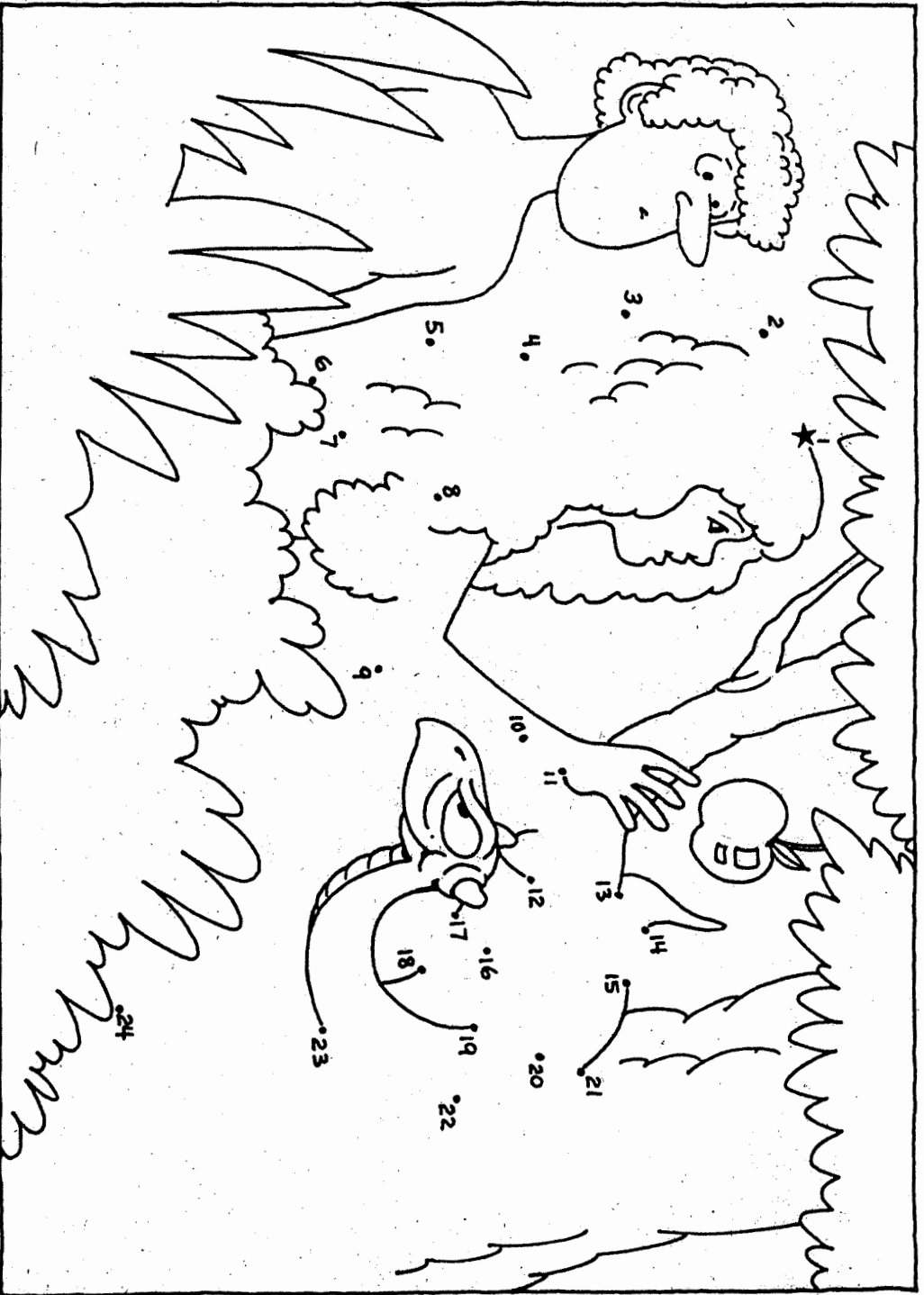
Because they disobeyed Him, God sent Adam and Eve out of the beautiful Garden of Eden.

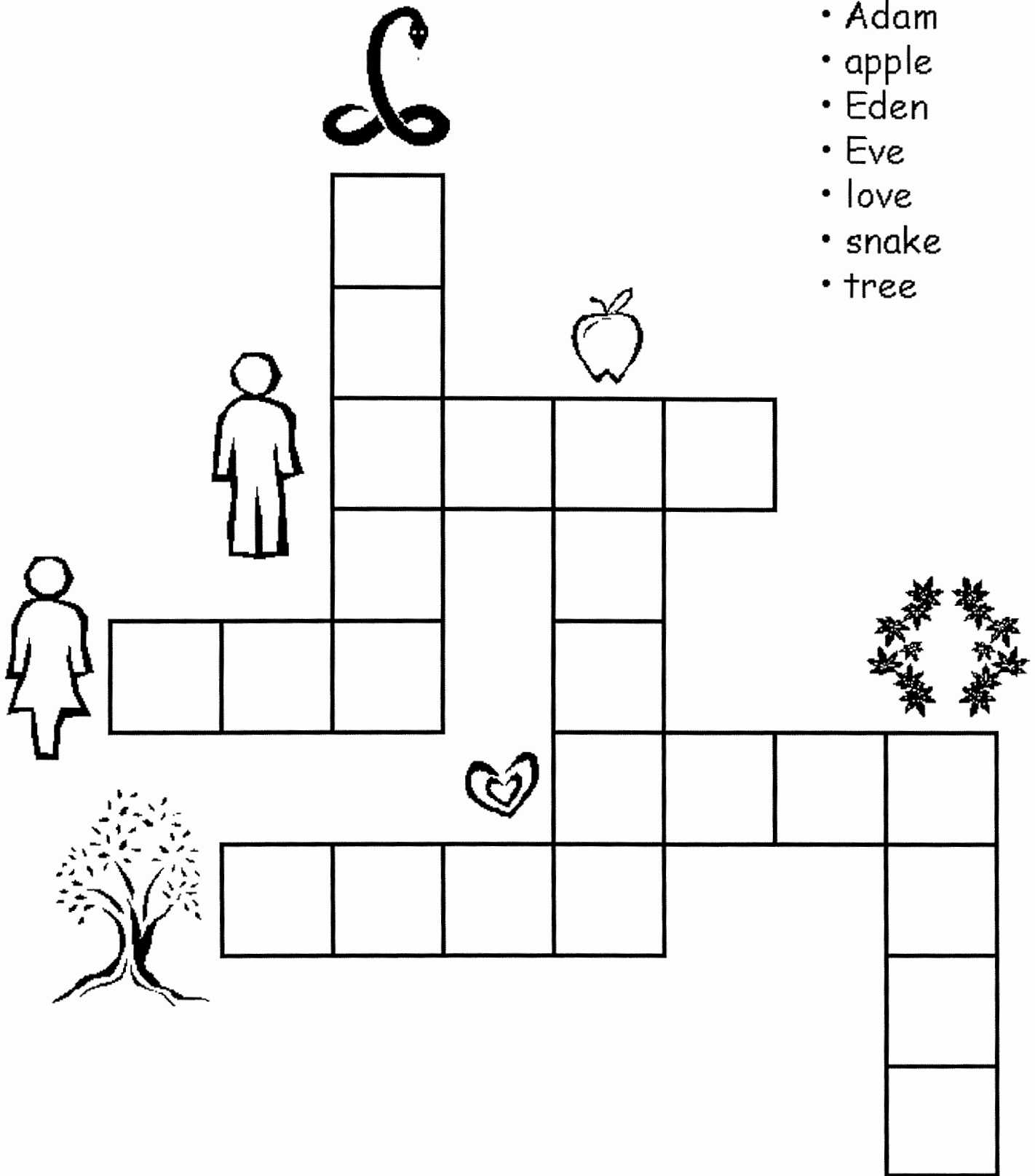

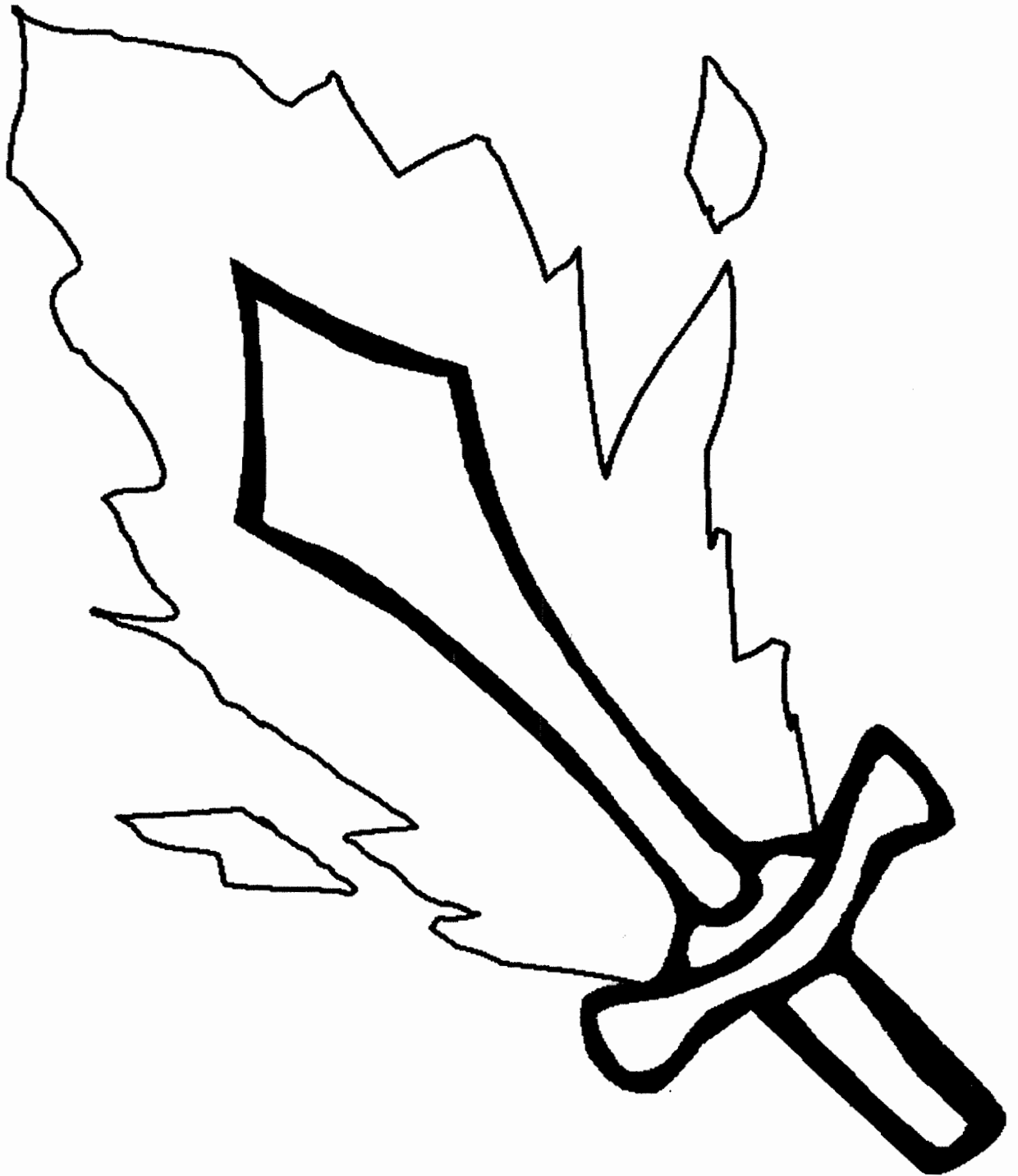

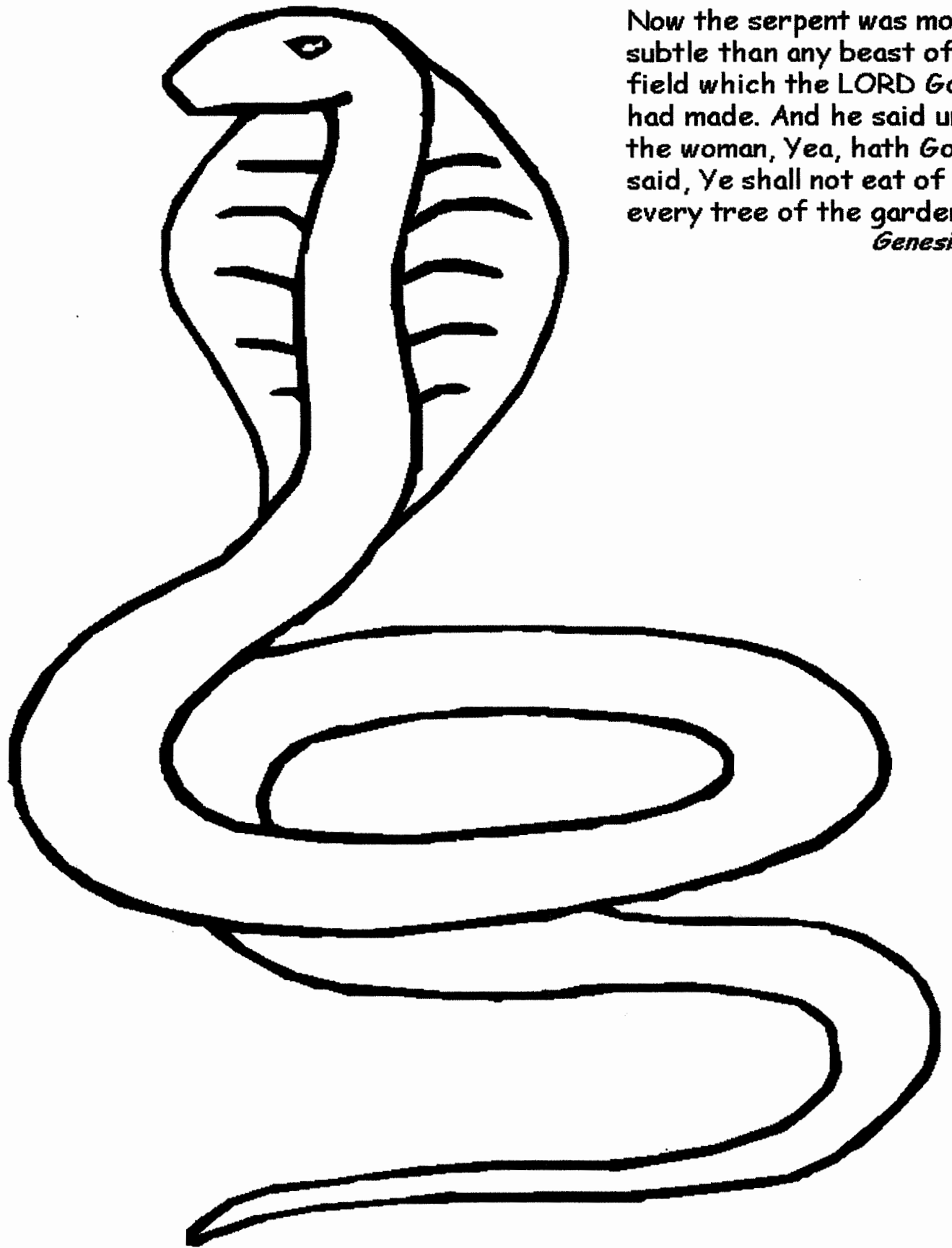
