Key Verse

Genesis 4:4-5, "Abel also brought of the firstborn of his flock and of their fat. And the LORD respected Abel and his offering, [5] but He did not respect Cain and his offering. And Cain was very angry, and his countenance fell."

Key Points

- 1. Cain and Abel were the first two sons of Adam and Eve.
- 2. The brothers offered sacrifices, but God only accepted Abel's sacrifice.
- 3. Cain was angry, and God encouraged him to resist the temptation to act out in anger.
- 4. Cain killed Abel; he was banished from God's presence.
- 5. God marked Cain so that no one would kill him.
- 6. Cain's descendant Lamech was a violent man like his forefather.
