

Key Points


- 1. God saw how wicked people had become and was sorry He had made them.

- 6. After about a year, God commanded Noah, his family, and animals to leave the ark. Noah immediately built an altar and worshiped God for His saving protection.
- 7. God set up seasons that He promised would not cease. Animals would be given to man to eat.
- 8. God made a covenant (promise) to never again destroy the earth by water. He put a rainbow in the sky to remind man of His promises.





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




On the Ark

Noah's Ark Crossword








A Sign From God
