Lesson 7 - Job

Job 1-2, 42

Key Verse

Job 1:20-22, “Then Job arose, tore his robe, and shaved his head; and he fell to the ground and worshiped. [21] And he said: ‘Naked I came from my mother's womb, And naked shall I return there. The LORD gave, and the LORD has taken away; Blessed be the name of the LORD.’ [22] In all this Job did not sin nor charge God with wrong.”

Key Points

1. Satan presented himself before God. God asked Satan if he had noticed Job, a man God describes as the most blameless man of his time.
2. Satan accused God of over-protecting Job.
3. God allowed Satan to tempt Job. Satan killed Job's children in a windstorm, sent thieves to steal some of his wealth, and sent fire from heaven to consume his livestock. Job did not curse God.
4. God allowed Satan to tempt Job a second time by afflicting him with boils from head to foot. Job did not curse God this time either.
5. Because Job was faithful in the face of his trials, God rewarded him with greater wealth than he had known before his temptations.
