
## Lesson 10 - The Covenant of Circumcision Genesis 17-18

### Key Verse


Genesis 17:9, "And God said to Abraham: 'As for you, you shall keep My covenant, you and your descendants after you throughout their generations.""

## Key Points


- 1. Although 15 years had passed, God had not forgotten His promise that Abram and Sarah would have a son.

- 6. God listened to Abraham's petition and showed mercy to Lot.







#### MEMORY VERSE




