- 5. How do the events and outcomes in Joshua 6-8 illustrate the themes of obedience and disobedience to God's commands, and what can we learn from Joshua's leadership through success and failure?
- 6. How can the principles of obedience to God's guidance and accountability for one's actions, as demonstrated in Joshua 6-8, be applied to your personal life?
